## Division MEET At Klein Forest High School

**The Divisional Meet** Saturday will be held at Klein Forest HS. Swimmers will camp out in our team area of the gym. Swimmer check-in is from 7:00-7:15am (please find the check-in person before heading to your age group area). Warm-ups will begin at 7:30. **ALL swimmers MUST warm-up.** This allows the swimmers a chance to familiarize themselves with the pool.

Divisional Meet Rules and Scoring – To be eligible to participate in the divisional meet, you have to have swum in at least two dual meets. Only official times can be used for individual and relay entries.  
**Scoring for all events, including relays, is 7-5-4-3-2-1.**
